

The 2025 Poland Spring x New York Yankees Tickets Sweepstakes

Official Rules

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. A PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.

1. Eligibility: The 2025 Poland Spring x New York Yankees Tickets Sweepstakes (the “Sweepstakes”) is open only to legal residents of New York, Connecticut, New Jersey, and Pennsylvania in select counties as outlined in the Appendix, who are at least eighteen (18) years old at the time of entry and who are members of the Rewards Drop™ loyalty program. Membership is free but subject to the listed [Terms & Conditions](#). Employees of BlueTriton Brands, Inc. (“Sponsor”), MLB Entities, Merkle Inc. Participation constitutes entrant’s full and unconditional agreement to these official rules (“Official Rules”). For purposes of this Sweepstakes, a “day” is defined as starting at 12:00 a.m. ET and ending at 11:59 p.m. ET, except the first day which starts at 9:00 a.m. ET and ends at 11:59 p.m. ET and the last day which

starts at 12:00 a.m. ET and ends at 5:00 p.m. ET. Administrator's computer is the official time-keeping device for the Sweepstakes.

4. How to Enter: During the Promotion Period, there are two (2) ways to enter the Sweepstakes, as outlined below.

- a. **Redeem Drops:** Visit www.rewardsdrop.com and follow the links and instructions to login to your Rewards Drop account. If you are not a Rewards Drop member, follow the links and instructions to sign up. Once you are logged in, navigate to the Poland Spring catalog. Next, follow the links and instructions to select the Sweepstakes item within the catalog. Follow the links and instructions to redeem twenty-five (25) Drops* and you will receive one (1) Sweepstakes entry into the Prize Pool drawing you selected.
- b. **Mail-in Alternate Method:** *To enter without redeeming Rewards Drop Drops, accurately provide the following information: your name, address, day and evening phone numbers, email address associated with your Rewards Drop account, and date of birth on a piece of paper and mail it in an envelope with proper postage to "2025 Poland Spring x New York Yankees Tickets Sweepstakes," c/o Merkle Inc., P.O. Sponsor is not responsible for lost, late, incomplete, invalid, unintelligible, illegible, misdirected or postage-due entries, which will be disqualified.

Important: Please review your Rewards Drop profile to ensure that it is complete and includes your real name and email address. Inaccurate information could impact your ability to win a prize.

Limit: You may enter one (1) time per day during the Promotion Period, regardless of method of entry. Multiple entrants are not permitted to share the same email address. In the event of a dispute as to the identity of an entrant, Sponsor and Administrator will rely on the information submitted by the entrant to register for this Sweepstakes (or where applicable to enroll in Rewards Drop). If any additional information provided by entrant is inconsistent with the information provided at registration for this Sweepstakes or enrollment into Rewards Drop, Sponsor and/or Administrator may disqualify such entrant and such disqualification may result in the forfeiture of any prizes won. The potential winners will be notified by email or phone. Each potential winner will be required to sign and return a Declaration of Compliance, Liability Waiver and where not prohibited Publicity Release ("Declaration") which must be received by the Administrator within three (3) days of the date notice or attempted notice is sent, in order to claim their prize. Each prize winner will also be required to disclose their social security number for the purpose of issuance of a Form 1099-Misc for tax purposes. If a potential winner cannot be contacted, fails to sign and return the Declaration or provide any other requested information within the required time period (if applicable), or the prize is returned as undeliverable, the potential winner forfeits their prize. The winner is solely responsible for all travel, lodging and any other expenses associated with attending the game. By traveling and attending the game, winner and guests voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19. Failure to comply with any required COVID-19 requirements may result in forfeiture of the tickets. Approximate Retail Value ("ARV") of each Grand Prize: \$1,016.00 (\$254.00 per ticket). Prizes are non-transferable and no substitution will be made except as provided herein at the Sponsor's sole discretion. Sponsor reserves the right to substitute a prize for one of equal or greater value if the designated prize should become unavailable for any reason. Winners are responsible for all taxes and fees associated with prize receipt and/or use. Winners will receive an IRS Form 1099 MISC reporting the actual value of the prize received. All other costs and expenses associated with acceptance of the prize that are not expressly set forth herein shall be solely the winner's responsibility. Prizes are provided "as is" without warranty of any kind, either express or implied, including but not limited to, the implied warranties of merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose or non-infringement. Each winner and his/her guest(s) agree to comply with all applicable ballpark and venue regulations in connection with the prize; see yankees.com/ballpark for details. Sponsor and the MLB Entities reserve the right to remove or to deny entry to any winner and/or his/her guest(s) who engage in a non-sportsmanlike or disruptive manner or with intent to annoy, abuse, threaten, or harass any other person at the game/event/exhibition. Released Parties (as defined below) will not be responsible for weather conditions; acts of God; acts of terrorism; civil disturbances; local, state, or federal regulation, order, or policy; work stoppage; epidemic, pandemic, or any other issue concerning public health or safety; or any other event outside of their control that may cause the cancellation or postponement of any Major League Baseball game/event/exhibition. Major League Baseball game/event/exhibition tickets awarded as prizes may not be resold, offered for resale, or used for any commercial or promotional purpose whatsoever. Any such resale or commercial or promotional use may result in disqualification and prize forfeiture and may invalidate the license granted by the game/event/exhibition ticket.

7. In such event, Sponsor, in its sole discretion, may elect to hold a random drawing from among all eligible entries received up to the date of discontinuance and may modify the prizes offered herein. Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Sweepstakes, including but, not limited to submitting fraudulent entries, or to be acting in violation of the Official Rules of this or any other promotion or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion. In addition, if any provision contained in these Official Rules shall for any reason be held to be excessively broad as to duration, geographical scope, activity or subject, it shall be construed by limiting and reducing it, so as to be enforceable to the extent compatible with applicable law.
